## What are **MONOCLONAL ANTIBODIES?**



Monoclonal antibodies (**mAbs**) are antibodies developed in a laboratory to help our bodies fight infection.

If you are more likely to get very sick from COVID-19, your healthcare provider might recommend that you receive investigational treatment.

Monoclonal antibodies are a treatment [authorized by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration](#) (FDA) for use in adult and pediatric patients who have either been diagnosed or exposed to someone with COVID-19 and are at high risk for progression to severe illness, hospitalization, or death from COVID-19.

**People should talk to their medical provider about whether the use of monoclonal antibody treatment is appropriate for them.**
